We therefore resolve to participate as a supporter for the Welcoming Clubs Network and commit to taking the following steps toward creating an environment that unlocks the full potential of all members of the community:

- Become a supporter of the welcoming clubs network, an informed collaboration of organisations that are committed to supporting local clubs in welcoming and inclusion events, programs and activities.
- Identify at least one key contact that will liaise directly with the Welcoming Clubs team.
- Communicate regularly with the Welcoming Clubs team through one conference call each year and an annual in-person meeting, to progress planning and share and learn from practices of other welcoming clubs and/ or supporters.

We understand that the Welcoming Clubs network involves a number of key elements:

Knowledge sharing: Supporting sporting codes and clubs to access evidence-based research, policies, case studies and leading practice.

Partnership brokering: Facilitating cross-sector collaboration and brokering multi-sector partnerships to maximise learning, reach and impact.

Celebrating success: Sharing good news stories and recognising the existing efforts of sporting codes and clubs that demonstrate leading practice and innovation in welcoming efforts.

Standard & Accreditation: Setting the Standard for cultural diversity and inclusion policy and practice in sports and recreation.

Local clubs participate as *members* of the Welcoming Clubs network, while community organisations, sport governing bodies, businesses and other agencies are involved as *supporters*. Both *members* and *supporters* can access key elements of the network.
